Performing Art, Artwork & Exhibits - in person at Acton United Methodist Church 3433 Fall Creek Hwy. on either 2/25/24 from 3-5 pm or 2/26/24 from 5-7pm.

ALL ENTRIES: Must complete one Registration Form per Entry: https://bit.ly/SHF2024 - (case sensitive). Limit of 2 entries per year in different categories.

AWARDS Reception and Ceremony will be held at Acton United Methodist Church on Friday, March 1st, starting at 5:00 pm. All entries will be available to view and vote for People's Choice Award from 5:00-6:15 pm.

All Entries **MUST** be picked up at the end of the awards ceremony at 6:30 pm on March 1st at Acton United Methodist Church. All entries not picked up will be discarded.

Rules For Entry

ALL CATEGORIES:

- **★** Complete ONE <u>Registration Form</u> For Each Entry: (case sensitive)
- **★** Must relate to the 2024 Student History Fair theme "Turning Points in Texas History"

Research Paper:

- ★ Must work alone
- * Must be original, factual and historically based
- ★ Must be typed and double-spaced
- ★ Word count: less than 1,000 words, provided on cover sheet
- * Must provide a list of sources
- ★ Submitted electronically (PDF only) on Registration Form, e-mail or mail by 2/2/24

Creative Writing Paper:

- ★ Must work alone
- * Must be original, factual and historically based.
- ★ Must be typed and double-spaced
- ★ Word count: less than 1,000 words, provided on cover
- ★ Must provide a list of sources
- ★ Submitted electronically (PDF only) on Registration Form, e-mail or mail by 2/2/24

Exhibits:

- ★ Work alone or in a group (5 people or less)
- * Exhibit size no larger than 40" wide, 30" deep, and 6' high.
- * Include any combination of photos, research paper, artwork, 3-D models, etc.
- ★ Submitted in-person 2/25/24 from 3-5 pm or 2/26/24 from 5-7 pm

Artwork:

- ★ Work alone or in a group (5 people or less)
- * Entries can include any painting/print style, sculpture, photography, or any other art form.
- ★ Must be mounted to hang or stable enough to display
- * Submitted in-person 2/25/24 from 3-5 pm or 2/26/24 from 5-7 pm

Performing Arts:

- ★ Work alone or in a group
- * May include ballads, scenes, duets, solo, choirs, etc.
- ★ Must be 10 minutes or less and memorized
- ★ Performed in-person 2/25/24 from 3-5 pm or 2/26/24 from 5-7 pm By Appointment ONLY

Criteria for Judging

- 1. Historical Content & Accuracy
- 2. Relates to 2024 Student History Fair theme "Turning Points in Texas History"
- 3. Organized Structure and Clearly Stated
- 4. Creativity and Uniqueness of the subject matter
- 5. Demonstrates abundant research
- 6. Grammar, Punctuation, and Spelling (if applicable)
